INVITATION TO COMPETE IN THE INTERNATIONAL FILM FESTIVAL OF THE NON-COMMERCIAL FILM OF THE „WALSER FILM DAYS“

An international film competition of the non-commercial film with an unrestricted topic organized by the Film and Video Club Wals-Siezenheim, with the support of VÖFA (Association of Austrian Film Authors)

Time is from **20st to 23th October 2011**



Submission and registration by **1st September 2011**. Films received after this date cannot be accepted. Film registration form and competing films are to be submitted on schedule.

Only amateur films in the format of a Mini-DV or DVD are eligible for submission. Each competitor can submit two films. However, when entering two films two separate data carriers (in one envelope) should be submitted.

The length of a film is limited to **30 minutes** (Minute-Cup: 1 minute).

Should a film run longer than 30 minutes then the preliminary jury decides on its submission to the main competition.

The film entries are evaluated by a preliminary jury and the qualifying films are submitted to the main competition.

Those films submitted for the main competition are then presented publicly on the festival days and judged by an international jury. Those qualifying films marked with an asterisk (*) will be presented and judged only in the presence of the film author/filmmaker.

Event venue is the Bachschmiede in Wals-Siezenheim near Salzburg.
